



The White Rock Renegade Ben Squires Memorial Scholarship is in tribute to the memory of Ben Squires, a long time White Rock Renegade enthusiast. Ben was an admirer of the elite level fastpitch players and was a frequent spectator of games at Softball City and other fastpitch venues. Because of Ben's gentle nature and support of "great kids", we have chosen to honor athletes that are well rounded and demonstrate a sense of citizenship, leadership and community involvement.

CRITERIA

- ✓ Demonstrates a record of leadership with her Renegade team and Association, as well as other sports and/or activities in the community.
- ✓ Demonstrates a record of good citizenship as a student and player in the community.
- ✓ Players wishing to apply for this award must have completed a minimum one (1) year with the Renegades.
- ✓ Intends to stay involved in the Renegade Association as a player, coach, clinician, mentor or volunteer.
- ✓ Written intention to attend a post-secondary college, university or vocational school.
- ✓ Applicants will come from players who were born in 1992 and currently in their Grade 12 high school year.

Specifically, this scholarship is not evaluated on the following criteria:

- ▶ Athletic excellence
(albeit that any player playing for the White Rock Renegade Midget Club will likely be above average as an athlete.)
- ▶ Academic excellence
- ▶ Financial need

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application procedure for this award is as follows:

- 1.** Applicants must provide the scholarship committee with a cover letter stating why they are a good candidate for this scholarship.
- 2.** Complete the application form and include scholastic achievements, awards, community involvement and any other interests or hobbies.
- 3.** In addition, applicants must also include two (2) letters of recommendation; one from a coach or assistant coach and the other from a different source. (e.g. teacher, counselor, employer, etc.)
